

Alcaraz on course for year's 4th title

Madrid: World No. 2 Carlos Alcaraz remained on track for his fourth title of 2023 by powering into the semi-finals of the Madrid Open with a 6-4, 7-5 win over Russia's Karen Khachanov on Wednesday.

Alcaraz managed to break the Russian's serve in the seventh game, closing the first set 6-4. However, the Spaniard began the second set a little distracted and allowed Khachanov to open up a 4-1 lead before he woke up to fight back and win the match in under two hours.

"Winning this match gives me a lot of confidence," Alcaraz said. "Karen had been playing at a high level and took me to the limit, it was decided by small details. I will train for Friday, but with a lot of tranquillity and calm, I will not be overwhelmed and I have to be fresh."

Alcaraz has reached 18 consecutive wins in Spanish clay-court tournaments since losing to Rafael Nadal in Madrid two years ago.

His winning percentage overall on clay is already the third-best since 2010 (62.3 per cent), behind only Nadal and Novak Djokovic.

World No.2's dreams Alcaraz has enjoyed a spectacular start to his career by winning a grand slam crown and three Masters 1000 titles as a teenager and said he dreams of becoming one of the game's all-time greats.

The Spaniard, who turns 20 on Friday, won the US Open last September to become the youngest man to top the world rankings.

The 'Big Three' of Roger Federer, Nadal and Djokovic have dominated men's tennis for nearly 20 years, collectively winning 61 grand slams. While only Djokovic and Nadal of the three are still active, Alcaraz said reaching their level will be a daunting task.

"Well, my dream in tennis right now is to become one of the best players in history," Alcaraz said.

"I want to be part of the best tennis players in history and I'll work for it."

Alcaraz, who is seeking a fourth title of the season after triumphs in Buenos Aires, Indian Wells and Barcelona, continues his Madrid title defence on Friday when he takes on Croatian Borna Coric in the semi-finals.

Alcaraz said he plans to play in Rome next week as he builds up to the French Open, which starts on May 26.

Iga Swiatek will face Veronika Kudermetova for a place in the final after the Russian beat American Jessica Pegula 6-4, 0-6, 6-4 and reached the Madrid Open semi-finals.

"I think it was a pretty solid and clean performance," Swiatek told a news conference after the match.

"I'm pretty happy with the way I focused. I was pretty consistent with my tactics and I think it paid off."

Indian boxers punch ahead

Tashkent: Narender Berwal advanced to the quarter finals after winning a closely-contested bout while Govind Sani and Deepak Kumar ended the pre-quarter finals at the IBA Men's World Boxing Championships here on Thursday.

With a quarter-final finish at the previous World Championships under his belt, Narender (e-92kg) began his quest for a medal by defeating Muhammad Abroriddin of Tajikistan 4-1.

Both pugilists had won bronze at the 2022 Asian Championships and went all out from the beginning in the neck-and-neck bout. Narender landed powerful punches and dodged his opponent's attacks from close range to have the upper hand in the first round.

The Hissar-born boxer continued to attack on the front foot in the next two rounds and won the bout. He will face the

2021 World Youth Championships bronze medalist Fernando Arzola of Cuba in the quarter-finals.

Earlier in the day, Govind (48kg) made light work of Mehron Shafiev of Tajikistan to secure a 5-0 win. Deepak (51kg), on the other hand, was also at his attacking best as he ousted Luis Delgado of Ecuador by an identical margin.

Mirabai set to 'take it easy' at Asia meet

Jinju: Tokyo Olympics silver medalist weightlifter Mirabai Chanu will once again spearhead the Indian challenge at the Asian Championships but she is unlikely to attempt the much-awaited 90kg snatch lift here on Friday.

The two-time Commonwealth Games champion had won silver in her last outing at the World Championships in December with an overall effort of 200kg (87kg + 113kg).

It was far from her personal best of 207kg (88kg + 119kg) and this time too, the former world champion 49kg lifter is not expected to test her limits.

"Mirai only has to participate. We will take it easy," head coach Vijay Sharma said. "She will just participate and lift 85kg (snatch)...110kg (clean and jerk), totals that she can easily get."

That means the wait for the coveted 90kg snatch lift could be longer. Chanu, who struggles with a back issue that affects her snatch, has been trying to work her way back since 2020.

But with the Olympics still a year away and the Asian Games scheduled in September, Chanu will have to peak at the right time.

The last time Chanu competed at the event in 2021, she made history by creating a new world record in the clean and jerk category, which still stands.

"We will create world records in the Olympic year. She was at her peak the last time she was here because the Olympics were just around the corner. The Paris Olympics

is next year. There is no point peaking now."

The Indian will renew her rivalry with the Chinese duo of Jiang Huihua and Hou Zhihui, who have the highest entry weights of 205kg each.

Zhihui is the reigning Olympic champion. Chanu, on the other hand, has the second-highest entry weight, along with two other lifters.


It will also be the first time Jeremy Lalrinnunga (67kg) and Achinta Sheuli (73kg) compete in an event since winning the gold at the Commonwealth Games last August.

While Jeremy had been nursing a thigh injury, Achinta had to withdraw from the World Championships in December at the last minute after he pulled his hamstring during the warm-ups.

The duo will aim to collect the necessary ranking points to qualify for the Paris Olympics.

The Asian Championship is the qualifying event for the 2024 Paris Olympics, where weightlifters will be cut from 14 at Tokyo Games to 10.
